

## Black male teachers were my father figures. They changed my life, and we need more of them (Hechinger Report)

Excerpt from the article: "Teacher shortages continue to disproportionately affect historically underserved communities. Black educators are leaving the profession in high numbers, and this reality harms an often vulnerable school population. Representation matters, and education is starving for it."

## Number of unique book titles challenged jumped nearly 40% in 2022 (NPR)

In 2022, 2,571 unique book titles were challenged or banned from public and school library shelves. This article from NPR identifies the most challenged books of 2022.

## **How Educators Transformed Their Tennessee School by Listening to Students** (The74)

Excerpt from the article: "Elizabethton and its educators are using youth voice and choice to improve their high school and community at large. This is one of XQ's research-based design principles for rethinking the high school experience. The goal is to create more meaningful, engaged learning that looks beyond the school's walls. By listening to students, Elizabethton's educators learned they also wanted something else: connections with trusting, caring adults."





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
